

In addition, Joe also participated in the New York State Regional Lacrosse Tournament in Binghamton, NY from July 22 - 24, 2019.







Trouble shooting laundry problems

HOW TO TACKLE



Save washable fall and winter fabrics from these mess makers in just a few steps

PINE TREE SAP

Soak in rubbing alcohol to soften, then gently peel off what you can. Work in more alcohol to dissolve any remaining stain. Rinse. Rub in pretreatment, and wash in the warmest water that's safe.

PUMPKIN

Scrape off excess and flush with cold water. Rub in liquid laundry detergent or pretreatment. Wait five minutes, then wash in the hottest water that's safe with a fabric-safe bleach.

APPLE CIDER

Flush with cold water. Work in liquid laundry detergent or pretreatment, and wash in warm or, if safe, hot water. If the stain remains, rewash and add in a fabric-safe bleach.

CRANBERRY SAUCE

Rinse with cold water. Soak 15 minutes in a mix of 1 tbsp. white vinegar and 1/2 tsp. liquid detergent in 1 qt. cool water. Launder as usual in warm water with fabric-safe bleach.

Questions and Answers

Undissolving Detergent

: I like the convenience of laundry detergent pods, but they don't always fully dissolve in the wash. Help!



: Big differences between brands can be found, so if you had problems, try switching products. The guickest dissolvers were found to be Ajax, Target's Up&Up and Good Housekeeping Seal's star Tide. To make sure the pod dissolves completely, especially in a lowwater washer, put it in before adding clothes. Place it close to the incoming water stream, and keep it from getting trapped, avoid overloading the machine. If you see that a pack hasn't fully dissolved, check all garments carefully before putting them in the dryer and rewash any that are stained with residue.

Tip of the Meek

HOW TO CLEAN Three Types of SNEAKERS

CANVAS

Can go through the wash on a delicate cycle with cold water and mild detergent. Ideally, you should spotclean with a toothbrush and a mixture of warm water and baking soda. Let the shoes air-dry, and wipe away any hardened soda with a damp cloth.

NYLON MESH


Ventilates running shoes but also catches dust and dirt. Remove dirt with a brush, then mix equal parts vinegar and baking soda and let some sit on the dirtiest spots for 15 minutes. Scrub the shoe, wipe it clean, and let it air-dry. Avoid the washing machine - the water harms the foam - and never use the dryer.

SYNTHETIC LEATHER

Can be wiped with warm water and mild laundry detergent.
Scrub with a brush, wipe with a damp rag, and air-dry.



The world's top specialist for tour laundry, 62 year old Hans-Jürgen Topf has traveled with many of the world's biggest musical acts, including Madonna, Pink, U2, the Bee Gees, Beyoncé, among others.

The U2 tour alone, which lasted about seven months and spanned two continents, included roughly 150 people, all of whom needed food, housing and of course, clean clothes.

Topf's company, Rock 'n' Roll Laundry provides equipment and laundry staff for touring productions. Twenty years ago, most tour laundry had to be done quickly during tour stops at a local laundromat. That has completely changed within the musical touring industry.

When Topf is on tour, he begins almost every day by washing the performers' clothes, which usually have to be air-dried with a small fan. The most common stains on performers' clothes are sweat and aluminum dust from truck ramps carried on-stage by equipment-case wheels. The dust gets on the clothes when performers throw themselves on their knees or roll around on-stage.

When on tour, Topf will often spend three to four hours every afternoon ironing the performers' clothing, while simultaneously washing the crew's garments. After a show, the machines go into specially built rolling cases, so they can be loaded onto trucks and brought to the next location.
